- Be punctual in attendance and deadlines
- Participate in extracurricular activities
- Share team spirit
- Always remain attentive and alert with students

I will not

- Bring dangerous or valuable items to school
- Use walkmans, Discmans, IPods or mobile phones in class.
- Bring alcohol, drugs or other prohibited items to school
- Leave the campus during the school day without permission
- Show physical or verbal aggression to others
- Shout at or punish students in any form or method
- Breach the schools confidentiality policy by discussing school or students related issues
- Be negligent of my job description and responsibilities
- Speak ill of the institution or anyone within the school community (parents, students and staff)
- Leave my students unattended

We understand that by signing this document we have read and understood the code of conduct and that we will abide by it.

We also understand that should the student refuse to abide by these values and engage in behavior that is harmful to themselves or others, they run the risk of being asked to leave the school permanently.

The school will be responsible for working in partnership with parents and give comprehensive feedback at appropriate stages of the referral process.
