**About**

AIESEC Lebanon Exchange Program is designed to give university students and fresh graduates the opportunity to spend time on an internship in another country to gain a different perspective and to gain skills that will enable this participant to take this experience with them throughout their life.

**WHAT?**

For the period between the fall and spring semesters, AIESEC Lebanon gives university students of all majors the opportunity to go to a short term developmental internship in India and in Egypt. It's a serious opportunity for motivated students who are looking towards developing their "self-skills" and participating in a life changing cultural experience.

You'll be working with underprivileged children, with the elderly, and with disabled people. You will also help better educate people about these programs.

The first internship in Delhi - India, Project: "Make A Difference", will revolve around the following:

1. Working with underprivileged children in an NGO: Teaching these children basic communication/language skills, and establishing a highly interactive environment.
2. Building relationships with the elderly: Organizing listening sessions and establishing support systems through sympathizing with their problems and needs.
3. Administrative responsibilities include: Looking after accounts, filing, documentation, etc...
4. Other tasks include: Building a website for the organization, and increasing its online presence through effectively marketing the organization's mission statement. Also, raising funds for sustainability.

The second internship in Cairo- Egypt, Several Projects are available, and they are:

1. "Right to Live": A project that aims at preparing diverse workshops for people with disabilities, in order to enhance their skills.
2. "Think Green": A project which aims at raising environmental awareness through multiple approaches.
3. "Leave Your Finger Print": A project which revolves around working with underprivileged children, and teaching them life-long general skills that they will need in their lives, such as public speaking, language enhancement and so on. <http://vimeo.com/22572925>
4. "Horreya": A project concerned with women's rights and women empowerment.
5. "Paint a Clean Environment": A project which aims at raising environmental awareness through Art. It's implemented through two organizations: An Art School (CreaMagi-Nation Art School) and a UN Environmental Organization. They conduct workshops for children to learn arts and crafts through recycling and come up with creative ways to clean the environment.
6. "Make a Difference": A project that will implement any different topic than the mentioned above! Wider your imagination and broaden your horizons!

**WHEN?** It's a 2-3 weeks internship starting the end of January (Depending on your availability after the final exams)

**WHERE?** In either Egypt or India

**WHO?** Motivated university students and fresh graduates from all majors and backgrounds who are motivated to develop their "self-skills" and participating in a life changing cultural experience.

The aim of the internship is to provide the exchange participant with:

- A positive Learning experience
- Practical skills and knowledge in a foreign environment to complement the interns higher educational background or field of career aspirations
- Interaction with a different social and cultural environment with a view to gaining intercultural competencies and increase your global awareness
- Development of theoretical and practical leadership skills
- Opportunity to apply personal and professional skills, knowledge, attitudes and values to work for the organization as well as the host communities
- Awareness and knowledge of social issues and different practices of the sending and the host country
- Opportunity to contribute to personal and professional life goals
