



CAMPAIGN UPDATES



June 29, 2021

Dear AUB Community,

This second weekly update from the Vaccination Working Group (VAX-WG) contains important information for priority AUB recipients of the Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine. Please read carefully to ensure you benefit from the phased vaccination campaign. As we announced last week, first doses of the vaccine are being administered in three phases:

Phase 1 – June 18 -July 9* – to allow summer access to campus

Phase 2 – July 12-23* – to allow access in the fall term

Phase 3 – July 30-August 30* – dependents and other target segments

*(*Dates are tentative, as they depend on the supply of vaccines from the Ministry of Public Health)*

In order to complete Phase 1, AUBMC will provide a **walk-in vaccination service** on **Wednesday June 30 and Thursday July 1, 2021**, between **4:00 pm and 8:00 pm**. The goal is to administer the first doses of the vaccine to all remaining unvaccinated members of the AUB community in the following categories:

- **students who have registered for summer classes**
- **current dorm residents**
- **faculty and instructors teaching summer courses**
- **staff who need to access campus**
- **individuals who were already invited to receive their vaccine but missed the appointment**

A total of 700 vaccines will be available to people in these categories on each of the walk-in days. To receive your vaccine, please come to the Saab Medical Library after 3:00 pm on the day you wish to be vaccinated (tomorrow or Thursday) and you will be able to collect a token that will ensure you get your dose on the same day.

If you are a student or faculty member not involved in summer courses but you have a valid reason for receiving the vaccine early (for example travel, or medical necessity), please contact us on aubmc_safety@aub.edu.lb and we will validate and accommodate your request.

If you have already received your first dose of the Pfizer vaccine, you will be contacted with details of when to come for your second vaccination within a period of six weeks.

For those not eligible for vaccination in Phase 1, please await further communication from the VAX-WG about when you should come for your shots.

- **Complete the campaign Survey:** So far 5,286 members of the AUB community have already completed the “AUB Covid-19 Vaccination Campaign Survey”, which helps us understand the vaccine demand and craft a campaign that responds to your needs. Whether you took the vaccine or not, whether you plan or do not plan to take it, we want to hear your opinion!

The form is available also in Arabic and it is anonymous, unless you want to indicate your intention to get the vaccine. If you have not completed the survey yet, please do so today and invite your friends and colleagues to do the same:
