Abstract: Zeine Nour-Ed-Dine Zeine (1908-1996), historian, alumnus (BA, 1929; MA, 1945), & Professor at the American University of Beirut (AUB) (1930-1974). The Zeine Nour-Ed-Dine Zeine collection contains biographical information, addresses, articles, press clippings, correspondence, honoring, and memorial ceremonies, in addition to material related to his work on the history of the Middle East, Europe, and Ottoman Empire. It is important for scholars interested in the history of the Middle East and Ottoman Empire.

Scope and Content

The Zeine Nour-Ed-Dine Zeine collection of 6 linear feet of archival documents includes Zeine's biographical information, addresses, articles, press clippings, correspondence, honoring and memorial ceremonies. The collection also contains material related to his work and research at AUB on the history of the Middle East, Europe and Ottoman Empire that are an invaluable source of information for scholars interested in those fields.

Biographical Sketch

Zeine Zeine (1908-1996), historian, born on April 5, 1908, in Haifa Palestine, son of Noureddine Zeine and Mrs. Nayyereh Zeine, a descendant of the founder of the Bahai Faith. In 1933, Professor Zeine married Miss Mary Howie (BA 1931), and they later had three children: Ramsey (BA 1961), Lina (BA 1970), and Soumaya (BA 1970). He started his education at the Collège des Frères des Ecoles Chrétiennes, American University of Beirut (BA 1929, MA 1945) and London University (Ph.D. 1956). Zeine was an instructor of Sociology and Assistant Director of West Hall between 1930 and 1932; instructor of French, Science, and history at the International College between 1930 and 1939. He joined the American University of Beirut as Adjunct Professor of History in 1945, to be promoted to the rank of Professor in 1957, held this position until 1974, and later became Emeritus Professor of Modern History of the Near East, 1974-1996. Zeine authored several books, among them several important titles such as Arab Turkish-Relations; The Emergence of Arab Nationalism; The Struggle for Arab Independence; Western Diplomacy and the Rise and Fall of Faisal's Kingdom in Syria; in addition to many articles and papers in both Arabic and English well known for their reference value. The Lebanese Government awarded Professor Zeine the Order of the Cedars, Chevalier Rank, in 1973. He passed away on October 17, 1996.
