



Indoor dining, fitness and entertainment venues must accept valid proof that you have received at least one dose of:

- Any COVID-19 vaccine authorized for emergency use or approved by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA);
- Any COVID-19 vaccine authorized for emergency use by the World Health Organization (WHO); or
- Any active COVID-19 vaccine used during a U.S.-based clinical trial.

Below is a list of COVID-19 vaccines that are accepted.
