Presentation about human rights study in Arab world by Fateh Azzam

The Issam Fares Institute for Public Policy and International Affairs is organizing a presentation on Arab States and UN Human Rights Mechanisms by Fateh Azzam, director of Asfari Institute for Civil Society and Citizenship and Senior Public Policy Fellow at IFI. The presentation will offer an analysis of Arab engagement with UN human rights mechanisms from 2005 to 2012. It is based on a study conducted by Azzam and published in 2013. The presentation will summarize issues raised by states and NGOs, assessing the recommendations of the human rights treaty bodies, and the Human Rights Council's Universal Periodic Review, resulting Arab states' acceptance and rejection of those recommendations. The research report was published by IFI in 2013.

The presentation will take place on Wednesday, April 16, 2014 from 1:00 pm to 2:30 pm in Issam Fares Institute (Green Oval), Auditorium.

Fateh Azzam holds an LLM in International Human Rights Law from the University of Essex. He was Regional Representative for the Middle East of the UN High Commissioner for Human Rights From 2006 until June 2012, Director of the Forced Migration and Refugee Studies Program at the American University in Cairo (2003-2006). He led the process of establishing the Arab Human Rights Fund and

Chairman of its Board of Directors until 2014, and has served on the boards of several Palestinian, Arab and international human rights organizations.
