AUB Honored on its 150th Anniversary:

Commemorative Stamp from the Ministry of Telecommunications and LibanPost

In recognition of the pioneering and enlightenment role of the American University of Beirut in Lebanon, the region and the world, LibanPost, in coordination with the Ministry of Telecommunications, has issued a commemorative stamp marking the American University of Beirut (AUB) 150th anniversary.

In keeping with the occasion, LibanPost also prepared 2,750 numbered first day covers. The covers as well as the 30,000 commemorative stamps are available at all LibanPost offices.
