



CAMPAIGN UPDATES



October 16, 2021

Dear AUB Community,

This week the “AUBe Vaccinated Campaign” administered **2,550 doses**, reaching a total of **49,989 doses**. More than **98%** of the AUB community, including students, faculty, and staff, is now vaccinated.

Next week (October 19-22, 2021), the AUB Immunization Center will be open from 8:00 am until 4:00 pm, Tuesday to Friday, for the **extended community**, only through the following [booking system](#).

The extended community includes:

- **Any patient who has ever visited AUBMC** for operations, emergencies, or visits in inpatient/outpatient clinics or departments; individuals will be asked to provide their mobile number, or Medical Record Number (MRN), or AUBMC patient card, or show their MyAUBHealth application
- Any AUB alumni and their dependents, such as parents and partners/spouses (AUB Alumni ID is required)
- Domestic workers (residency permit is required for foreign workers)
- Individuals with disabilities and special needs (above the age of 12)
- Taxi drivers and public transport drivers (public driving license is required)
- Adults aged 45 years and above

The AUB Immunization Center will continue the campaign for the **dependents of AUB faculty, staff, and students** (spouses, children 12 years old and above, parents, grandparents, siblings-in-law, children-in-law, and household members) from 8:00 am until 4:00 pm, Tuesday to Friday, only through the following [booking system](#).

The AUB Immunization Center will also continue the campaign for **unvaccinated AUB faculty, staff, and students**.

Those who already received their first dose will receive an SMS from the **COVAX platform** for their **second dose** appointment date (please come between 8:00 am and 4:00 pm).

There will be **no walk-in immunizations**. Vaccines will be administered to those who reserved their appointments through the booking system only.

Please make sure to **register on the [COVAX MOPH platform](#)** first in order for you to be able to take the vaccine. You will be asked to show the SMS (text message) that you will receive from the MOPH indicating your effective registration.
