



## CAMPAIGN UPDATES



December 18, 2021

Dear AUB Community,

The “AUBe Vaccinated Campaign” continued to administer **Pfizer BioNTech vaccine**, reaching a total of **72,675 doses**. More than **99%** of the AUB community, including students, faculty, and staff, is now vaccinated.

In the coming weeks, the AUB Immunization Center will be open from **8:00 am until 2:00 pm, Monday to Friday**, but will be closed on December 23, 24, and 31, 2021 and January 6, 2022.

### First Dose

The AUB Immunization Center is open for the **extended community** only through the following [booking system](#).

Based on the recent decision of the Lebanese Ministry of Public Health, the **extended community now includes anyone aged 12 years and above** (ID, passport or driving license is required for Lebanese, residency permit is required for non-Lebanese).

The AUB Immunization Center will continue the campaign for the **dependents of AUB faculty, staff, and students** only through the following [booking system](#).

### Second Dose

Those who already received their first dose will receive an SMS from the **COVAX platform** for their **second dose** appointment date (please come between 8:00 am and 2:00 pm).

### Third Dose

Also based on the recent decision of the Lebanese Ministry of Public Health, AUB will initiate providing **optional booster shots (3<sup>rd</sup> dose)** for **anyone aged 16 years and above**, has received their second vaccine dose (dose 2) **at least 5 months ago and did not test positive for COVID-19 during the past 5 months** (ID, passport or driving license is required for Lebanese, residency permit is required for non-Lebanese) through the following [booking system](#).

There will be **no walk-in immunizations**. Vaccines will be administered to those who reserved their appointments through the booking system only.

Please make sure to **register on the [COVAX MOPH platform](#)** first in order for you to be able to take the vaccine. You will be asked to show the SMS (text message) that you will receive from the MOPH indicating your effective registration.
