



## CAMPAIGN UPDATES



July 26, 2021

Dear AUB Community,

This is the sixth “**AUBe Vaccinated**” campaign email update. The campaign is progressing steadily: with the **850** doses administered last week, we reached a total of **9,550 doses, of which 7,650 first and 1,900 second dose.**

### What’s going to happen this week?

AUB Vaccination days will happen on Tuesday July 27, Wednesday July 28 and Thursday July 29 to the AUB faculty, staff and students. Individuals eligible to receive the vaccine this week include the following:

- **2<sup>nd</sup> Dose Vaccination:** Those who received their first dose and are **4-weeks** due for their second dose can come as walk-in during the vaccination days between 4:00 and 7:00pm.
- **1<sup>st</sup> Dose Vaccination:** AUB Faculty, Staff, and students who did not receive their first dose yet and booked an appointment for this week using the AUB VAX-GROUP Self-Scheduling System. First dose vaccination is accepted only by pre-scheduled appointments. We have a limited number of 1<sup>st</sup> dose vaccines and will be distributed on First-Booked, First-Served Basis. On arrival to the vaccination center, be ready to show the following information:

- A valid **identification document** (driving license, passport, identity card, residency permit)
- **AUB ID** for faculty, staff, and students
- The text message indicating your **registration on the COVAX platform**
- The second dose invitation SMS received from AUBMC or MOPHCOVAX (second dose only)
- The booking confirmation email message from the AUB Vaccination Working Group (1<sup>st</sup> dose only)

### AUBe Vaccinated: fighting COVID together

- **AUBe Vaccinated:** The number of COVID-19 cases has started to increase again; consider taking the Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine as soon as possible. The earlier you take the vaccine, the better you can protect yourself, your University, and your loved ones. Pfizer vaccine is safe and reduces the risk of suffering from severe consequences of the virus, and it’s effective also against the Delta variants.
- **Register for the vaccine:** If you have not already done so, register on the COVAX MOPH platform (<https://covax.moph.gov.lb/impactmobile/vaccine>).
