Dear AUB Community,

Last week, the AUB Immunization center administered 1,520 new doses, totaling **16,505** doses, 10,017 first, and 6,488 second doses.

This coming week, the AUBe Vaccination campaign schedule is the following:

- **Tuesday Aug 17, between 11:00 am – 7:00 pm**
- **Wednesday Aug 18, between 11:00 am – 7:00 pm**
- **Friday Aug 20, between 11:00 am – 7:00 pm**

Who is eligible to take the vaccine?

- AUB faculty, staff, and students
- **Dependents of Faculty and Staff:** parents, grandparents, partners, siblings, children (above the age of 16), son-in-law, sister-in-law, and domestic workers living with AUB staff and faculty members.
- **Dependents of all AUB students:** parents, grandparents, and siblings.

Faculty, staff, and students are kindly requested to accompany their dependents when visiting the vaccination center; faculty, staff, students, and their dependents will be asked to show their Identification Documents for proper verification.

Have you received a COVID-19 Vaccine outside AUB?

If you have received an immunization certificate from another institution in Lebanon or abroad, send your certificate (e.g., EU “Green Pass”, QR code scan in PDF or image) to vaxwg@aub.edu.lb, so that you could be granted access to campus in the Fall semester.

Have you caught COVID-19 recently?

If you got infected with COVID-19 in July and August 2021, send your positive PCR result to vaxwg@aub.edu.lb so that you are granted campus access in September, as you are at low risk of reinfection. However, you should schedule your vaccination as soon as you can. You can safely take the COVID-19 vaccine (according to [CDC guidelines](#)).
