



## CAMPAIGN UPDATES



July 13, 2021

Dear AUB Community,

This is the fourth “**AUBe Vaccinated**” campaign email update. The campaign is progressing steadily: with the **2,555** doses administered last week, we reached a total of **6,700 doses, of which 6,000 first** and **700 second doses**.

What’s going to happen this week?

This week, as we received a smaller amount of vaccine from the MOPH, we are able to administer up to 1200 vaccines, we will continue offering the vaccines to unvaccinated members of the community who are currently in Lebanon, including:

- AUB / AUBMC **faculty, staff, and instructors**
- Currently registered **students** (Summer 2021 or Fall 2021-2022), including current dorm residents
- **Recent graduates** of the 2020 and 2021 classes

### First dose administration

If you are eligible and need to receive your first dose, please visit **Saab Medical Library** on Tuesday **July 13**, Wednesday **July 14**, or Thursday **July 15, 2021**, between **4:00 pm and 7:30 pm** to collect a token to receive the vaccine on the same day. There will be a dedicated booth for first dose recipients. Upon receiving your token, be ready to show the following information:

- The **invitation email** from the VAX-WG
- A valid **identification document** (driving license, passport, identity card, residency permit)
- Valid **AUB ID** for faculty, staff, and students
- The text message indicating your **registration on the COVAX platform**

### Second dose recipients

If you received your first dose on June 12, 16, 17, or 18, you may receive or have already received a text message from the MOPH with a time and date for your second dose. This

message is automatically generated by the COVAX platform based on the date and time of your first dose (approximately 28 days after). However, it is not aligned with the schedule of the AUBMC vaccination center. Please disregard the time and date of this text message appointment.

If you received your first dose between June 12 and 18, you should visit **Saab Medical Library** on Tuesday **July 13**, Wednesday **July 14**, or Thursday **July 15 2021**, between **4:00 pm and 7:30 pm** to get your second dose – find the booth for second dose recipients. Please note that you are required to show the **text message from the MOPH** indicating the date and time of your second dose.

The Vaccination Working Group is piloting a booking system for first and second doses that will reduce the waiting times and the queues. The booking system is under development, and we will let you know when it is ready to be used. For this coming week, please allocate 1-1.5 hours for your visit at the AUBMC vaccination center to account for potential queues.

#### AUBe Vaccinated: fighting COVID together

- **AUBe Vaccinated:** The number of COVID-19 cases has started to increase again; consider taking the Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine as soon as possible. The earlier you take the vaccine, the better you can protect yourself, your University, and your loved ones. Pfizer vaccine is safe and reduces the risk of suffering from severe consequences of the virus, and it's effective also against the Delta variants
- **Register for the vaccine:** If you have not already done so, register on the Covax MOPH platform (<https://covax.moph.gov.lb/impactmobile/vaccine>).
