SYLLABUS CVSP 216 (3 credits) A Survey of 20th Century French Literature in English

1. Course description

This course offers an approach of the Modern French literature of the XXth century with a special interest on how literary streams influenced other disciplines like arts, music, sociology, anthropology, and psychology opening the way to the XXIst century.

2. Course objectives

- a- Analyzing and debating the stimulating intellectual life of the XXth century that brought together visions of social sciences and artistic or literary works.
- b- Acquisition of a complete and critical knowledge of the principal steps in literary and artistic XXthe century French Modernity and of its most representative authors.
- c- Acquisition of reading and analysis techniques of the texts (response essays, and oral presentations) through the recognition of the different themes, styles, and specificities of each art stream in the program.
