Containment	Type of Waste	Examples
	1. Cytotoxic Drugs Wastes 2. Pathological Wastes	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▶ Chemotherapeutic▶ Cytotoxic▶ Vaccines▶ Human organs, tissues, body parts...
	Solid Biohazardous Wastes	Contaminated: <ul style="list-style-type: none">▶ Gloves & other Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)▶ Plastic-ware▶ Towels▶ Bench papers▶ Examination papers...
	Cytotoxic Drugs Sharps	Sharps contaminated with Chemotherapeutic & Cytotoxic drugs in addition to vaccines ex: needles, scalpels, broken glass, razors...
	Biohazardous Sharps	Sharps contaminated with blood or body fluids ex: needles, scalpels, broken glass, razors...
	Regular Wastes	Any other wastes that are not contaminated with any hazardous materials such as blood, body fluids, cytotoxins...
