All students admitted as sophomores are eligible to continue in the program provided they obtain, by the end of their third regular semester at AUB, a minimum average of 70 or 2.3 (C+) in their biology courses.

Note: FAS students cannot be given credits for the following courses: NFSC 220, AVSC 279, and AVSC 280.

In addition, Biology students cannot be given credits for the following courses: MATH 203, MATH 204, and AGSC 219.

BIOL 296 (a 0-credit exit survey) must be taken by the end of the last Spring term of study.
