Interested in completing a Teaching Diploma while working on your BSc or BA degree?

Students working for a Bachelor of Science (BSc) or a Bachelor of Arts (BA) degree in a school subject may complete a Teaching Diploma along with their Bachelor's degree. A BSc or a BA in a school subject (sciences, mathematics, language, and social sciences) plus a 21 credit Teaching Diploma is recognized by the Government of Lebanon as equivalent to the License D'Enseignement – i.e. if a total of 111 credits (not including the freshman year) is completed. Completion of a teaching diploma will cover the pre-requisite requirements for an MA in Education in the same field of specialization.

Requirements for the Teaching Diploma in Secondary Education

Methods courses at the secondary level are subject matter oriented, i.e., they deal with teaching a subject matter, which has been chosen by the student as a major field of specialization.
