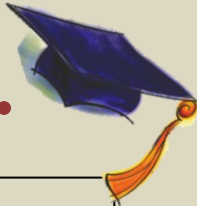


The MA in English Language or Literature...

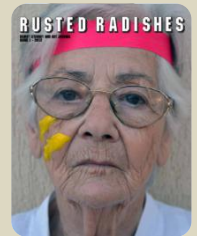
