^b If exempted from the Arabic Language requirement, students **MUST TAKE** any 3-credit course in Humanities or any language course including Arabic as a foreign language.

^c Must be chosen from the updated list of the General Education requirements found on the registrar's website.

^d If exempted from ENGL 203, students **MUST TAKE** ENGL 204. They should also take any 3 credits free elective (level 200 or above) to complete the 120 credits required for graduation.

^e For prerequisites or corequisites, check the AUB Undergraduate Catalogue.

^f Students who elect CVSP 205 **MAY NOT** enroll in CVSP 201 or 202. Students who elect CVSP 206 **MAY NOT** enroll in CVSP 203 or 204 or versa.

^g Students who cannot fulfill the Arabic Communication Skills requirement will be asked to sit for an Arabic Placement Test. According to the results, they may take ARAB 201A to replace the Arabic Communication Skills requirement.
