Students working for a Bachelor of Science (BSc) or a Bachelor of Arts (BA) may complete a **Diploma in Educational Management and Leadership** along with their Bachelor's degree. The purpose of this diploma is to provide knowledge and practical training in the areas of educational management and leadership. Holders of this diploma will be prepared to hold managerial and leadership positions in schools and educational training institutions and programs. Completion of the diploma will cover the pre-requisite requirements for MA in Educational Administration and Policy Studies.
