Rima Nakkash holds a doctorate in Public Health Policy from the London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine (LSHTM), UK. She has been working in the field of tobacco control since 1998; her research includes tobacco control prevention and policy with regional and international relevance. Other research interests include community based participation, intervention evaluation particularly with youth and disadvantaged populations, translation of evidence to policy, applied research ethics, and youth alcohol harm reduction policy.

She coordinates the American University of Beirut Tobacco Control Research Group, a multidisciplinary entity involving researchers from every faculty at AUB. She is a researcher and an advocate focusing on knowledge translation and impact. Dr. Nakkash is the Associate Director of the Knowledge to Policy Center a and the WHO FCTC Knowledge Hub for Waterpipe tobacco smoking at AUB.
