

Dr Ola El-Zein is the Director of the Medical Library and lecturer at the American University of Beirut (AUB).

Dr. Ola holds a PhD degree in Cell and Molecular Biology. She has extensive teaching experience at AUB and other universities since 2007. She is in charge of several research initiatives and projects and had published several research papers in prominent international journals. She works on supporting medical research and improving the quality of health information, knowledge, and research evidence to strengthen health systems and promote the dissemination of evidence-based information. She was chosen as the youngest woman scientist to participate in a plenary session about youth and science diplomacy in WSF2017. She was also nominated as a member of the organizing committee for the WSF-2019. Dr El-Zein serves as a board member of the Arab World Association of Young Scientists. She is the first country representative for Lebanon at Healthcare Information For All (HIFA).
