

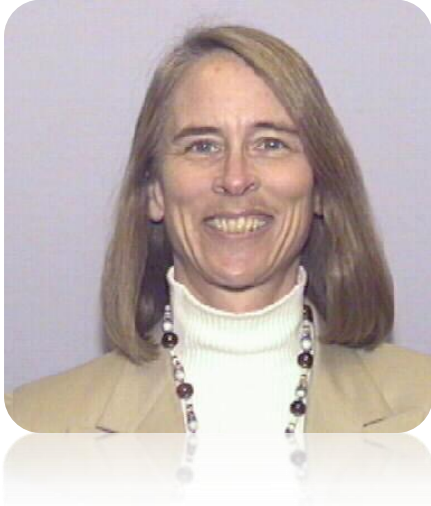


# Mediation in the School Environment with Dr. Haavi Morreim

Haavi Morreim, JD, PhD, is an academician, attorney and active mediator. Identified by the Tennessee Supreme Court as a mediator for litigated and non-litigated disputes in both civil and family matters, she has extensive experience mediating cases ranging across employment, contract, landlord-tenant, real estate, debtor-creditor and beyond.

Dr. Morreim is Vice-Chair of the American Bar Association's Task Force on ADR (Alternative Dispute Resolution) and Conflict Management in Health Care. She is also Vice-Chair of the American Health Lawyers Association/AHLA Affinity Group on Dispute Resolution. Additionally Dr. Morreim has completed AHLA's training for Peer Review Hearing Officers. Finally, she has also provided legal services in long-term care litigation.

As an academician Dr. Morreim has authored two books and over one hundred forty articles in journals of law, medicine, and bioethics, including California Law Review, Vanderbilt Law Review, Journal of the American Medical Association, Archives of Internal Medicine, Hastings Center Report, and the Wall Street Journal. She has presented hundreds of invited lectures nationally and internationally, to such groups as the American Bar Association, the American Health Lawyers Association, the American Medical Association, and the American College of Physicians.
