Ziad Majed is an Assistant Professor at the American University of Paris (This might change as of February 1, 2017, I will be promoted - in principle - to Associate Professor). He teaches Middle East studies and International affairs, and writes on Lebanese, Syrian and Arab questions as well as on regional political transitions and crises.

In 2007, he co-founded the “Arab Network for the Study of Democracy”. The network gathers scholars and activists from 11 Arab countries and publishes newsletters, studies and policy papers on current developments in the region.
