Scope and Content

These documents are the historical record of the accreditations of Abdul-Massih Massuh, a dentist from Hama, Syria. Dr. Abdul-Massih Massuh studied and practiced dentistry during the transition from Ottoman Empire to French Mandate and finally to independent Lebanon. The collection includes work permits, certificates, diplomas, and medical oath. The documents in the collection represent dentistry teaching and practice during early 20th C.

Biographical Sketch

Abdul-Massih Massuh, was born in Hama, Syria, 1902; graduated from the American Mission's Tripoli Boys' School in 1918. Then completed his studies at the Preparatory School of the Syrian Protestant College in 1920. Graduated from the School of Dentistry at the American University of Beirut in 1925. Received a permit to practice dentistry in Syria and Lebanon from the French High Commission in November 1925. His permit to practice dentistry was renewed by the Lebanese Department of Health of the Republic of Lebanon in 1944. Married Thurayya Saleeby and had two children: Souheil and Nuhad; practiced dentistry in Hama then Homs in 1926, later in Helba, Akkar, Lebanon. He returned to AUB to attend the commencement ceremony in 1933.
