Abstract: Salvador Arnita is a Palestinian composer and Organist. In 1949, Arnita settled in Beirut, joined the American University of Beirut (AUB) as Assistant Professor of Music 1950, and took different posts until his retirement as Professor of Philosophy (Music, Kapellmeister) in 1979-1980. His collection includes musical notes and partitions and most importantly his own musical compositions.

Scope and Content

The collection includes biographical information on Salvador Arnita; articles by his wife Yusra Jawhariyah Arnita; programs and performances, musical notes; invoice book; books for music teaching; Musical Partitions and Musical Compositions by him.

The collection is important for researchers who are interested in Music of the Middle East or in faculty involved in music and musical performances of the 20th century.

Biographical Sketch

Born in Jerusalem, Palestine, 1915. He showed an early aptitude for music and became assistant organist at the historic Church of the Holy Sepulchre at the age of eleven. At sixteen, he enrolled at St. Cecil's Academy Rome. Two years later, he went to London to study choral and orchestral conducting. At twenty, he was back in Jerusalem as Music Director of the YMCA. From 1949-1980 worked at AUB as Assistant Professor of Music, Associate Professor and Professor of Music and was a pillar of the Beirut musical scene. Salvador Arnita was "a complete musician having composed more than 200 original musical compositions, giving more than 100 organ recitals in the Middle East, Europe, and the United States, and conducting some of the world's major orchestras, such as the Guildhall Symphony, the Pittsburgh Symphony, the Torino Radio Orchestra, and the Berlin Symphony. Among his original compositions are three symphonies, four concerti (for organ, piano, flute, and viola), two suites, 10 piano preludes, two piano sonatas, four organ preludes and fugues, two string quartets, and a solemn hymn, "Centenarius," especially composed to commemorate AUB's centennial in 1966. International orchestras played many of these compositions. Awarded by Belgian Government the Legion D'honneur in 1962, and the Lebanese Government the Gold Medal (First Class) and by AUB the AUB Coin. Deceased in 1985. He was married to Yusra Arnita who was a holder of a Diplome de Musique (Paris) and taught music history and theory at AUB. She was the author of *Folkloric Arts in Palestine* and *Modern Music in its Contemporary Setting* both in Arabic.
