**AUB's Mouzakara Jandaria** is AUB MEPI-TLS's official digital publishing platform where writing is viewed as a form of activism. The aim of the publication is to increase gender literacy on campus as well as create a culture of writing about gender especially among students.

The publication is interested in giving a voice to students by providing them with a non-judgmental writing space to produce good quality content and publish without too many restrictions.

The platform is run by the MEPI-TLS team and a body of student editors who already have experience in editing in student-lead publications or in writing.

**Mouzakara Jandaria** targets the AUB community and beyond.

Their preferred genre is mainly **opinion pieces**:

1. They welcome opinion articles that give the authors' perspective on a topical issue and make a useful addition to the existing literature. Where appropriate, authors should make it clear where they are expressing their own personal views and why.
2. But they also accept purely **argumentative feature articles** and **critiques**. And all submissions are encouraged to have elements of personal experience

#### **What do our editors look for in a piece?**

- Short pieces that are generally around 500 - 1000 words in length and not beyond
- Any topic related to gender studies
- Mainly looking for opinionated pieces
- Good quality and fun/innovative content

#### **The process for submitting is as follows:**

- **Step 1:** Submit a completed version of your article to the following email: [mepi.tls.writing@gmail.com](mailto:mepi.tls.writing@gmail.com) including a title, a short abstract of your article and its corresponding topic.
- **Step 2:** Upon receiving an email of acceptance for publication, you will need to reply by re-confirming your interest in publishing your articles in order to receive the editors' comments.
- **Step 3:** If the editors do not hear back from you, they will disregard your paper.
- **Step 4:** Edits – after you receive the editors' comments, submit a new amended version of your article accordingly.
- **Step 5:** Your article will be published on their website

#### **Information to include when submitting:**

##### **1. Personal Background:**

- What is your major?
- Why would you like to publish with AUB Working Papers in Gender Studies specifically?
- What are your interests as an author?

## **2. Title**

Please provide a concise and specific title that clearly reflects the content of the article.

## **3. Abstract**

Abstracts should be up to 150 words long and provide a succinct summary of the article.

Citations should not be used in the abstract. Abbreviations, if needed, should be spelled out.
