ZAHAWI MISSION

Chancellor Nadhim Zahawi is travelling to the U.S. this week to seek joint solutions to the cost-of-living crisis with leading bankers and government officials. He will push for co-operation on energy security, financial services and tackling spiralling prices.

NEW CANCER HOPE

Carol Hardy, 65, is surviving deadly bile duct cancer against all odds, thanks to a new experimental drug, RXC004, which contains a compound that blocks a pathway known to be over-activated in the disease. She is taking part in a clinical trial at Christie NHS Foundation Trust in Manchester.

PLEA TO HELP PUBS

Pubs and brewers are at risk of closure within months amid price rises of more than 300%, industry bosses have warned. Bosses of six of the UK's biggest pub and brewing companies have signed an open letter to the Government urging it to act in order to avoid "real and serious irreversible" damage.

RUSSIA WAR GAMES

Russia is holding war games drills in its east with China – a show of closer military ties between Moscow and Beijing.
