PROGRAM COURSES

MFIN is a one-year full-time program. 10 courses (3 credits each) of which 6 are core courses and 4 are electives.

MFIN is a structured program, it starts in the fall semester and continues for one year for a full-time student.

OSB also offers a part-time program to be completed in two years for students working full-time who have the approval of their employer to pursue the degree.

- Students with a non-quantitative background may be asked to take the GMAT or GRE exam.
- Two letters of recommendation highlighting the applicant's academic and/or work experience.
- Curriculum vitae.
